Transport Access Guide

Getting to Westmead Hospital

Westmead Hospital is a 26 kilometres west of the Sydney CBD, and 2 kilometres west of Parramatta.

The main entrance to Westmead Hospital is located on Darcy Road.

The entrance to the Emergency Department is located on Hawkesbury Road.

Train Services

Westmead Train Station is serviced by the Western and Cumberland lines.

Westmead Train Station is 250 metres from the hospital and is approximately an 8 minute walk. To walk to the hospital, exit the station onto Railway Parade, turn right at Hawkesbury Road and walk to the traffic lights at Darcy Road. Westmead hospital is on the corner of Hawkesbury and Darcy Roads.

Parramatta Train Station is serviced by the Western and Cumberland and lines.

The hospital is a 5 minute bus trip away using T-Way buses T61–T66 which depart from the Parramatta Train Station Interchange at Stand B4. The bus stops at Darcy Road.

Westmead and Parramatta train stations are both wheelchair accessible. For further details visit the Sydney Trains website: www.sydneytrains.info



T-Way Bus Services

T-Way Buses T61–T66 stop outside the hospital on Darcy Road. It is then a short walk to the main entrance to the hospital. Services run approximately every 15 minutes.

T-Way Buses offer wheelchair accessible services at limited times. Please consult the Transport Information Line and look for the accessible symbol to identify these services.

By Car

Entrance to the hospital campus is via Hawkesbury Road. The closest motorway to the hospital campus is the M4. Take the Cumberland Highway Exit and turn onto the Great Western Highway. From there, take the Darcy Road exit and follow the signs.

Please be aware that parking is limited on this campus and parking permits and fees apply.

Cycle Ways

Cycling options include on-road cycling on Hawkesbury Road and off road cycling through Parramatta Park.
